We are announcing the launch of our new Kodak Professional TRI-X 400 Single Use Camera.

Tell me more about this camera?

This new single use camera comes pre-loaded with 27 exposures of the world's most iconic black and white film, Kodak Professional TRI-X 400.

This is a Power Flash model, right?

That's correct. The Power Flash camera features a double aspheric lens element, plus a built-in flash that automatically recharges to take the worry out of taking photos indoors.

When should I use the flash?

For best results, use the flash for any indoor photography. To shoot an indoor portrait, the ideal flash range is 1 meter (3 feet).

What about outdoor photography?

The TRI-X 400 single use camera will respond best to daylight and sunlit scenes.

Where should I go for B&W processing and printing?

Your TRI-X 400 Single Use Camera can be taken to any photo lab that develops B&W film. To find a location, use our [Film Finder](#) or do a web search for "black and white film processing and printing".

Can I process the film in my home darkroom?

Sure. It is fairly easy to remove the exposed film roll from the camera by removing the film door. **To avoid the risk of electrical shock, do not attempt to disassemble the camera.** For more information on processing Tri-X 400 in a home darkroom, please refer to the following Tech Pubs on our website:
